WW1 REMEMBRANCE

This year **Remembrance Day, 11th November 2018**, falls on a Sunday, uniquely, it is both Armistice Day and the 100th Anniversary of the end of hostilities in the First World War.

In Lyonshall Church: Remembrance service is at 11.00am.

In Hereford Cathedral: Daily from 5th to 10th November at 4.30pm the names of the county's First World War dead will be read in the Cathedral followed by Evensong at 5.30pm. A County Service of Remembrance for the end of the First World War will be held in the **Cathedral at 3.30pm on Sunday 11th November.**

Roads: Potholes will be logged quicker if you report them straight to **Herefordshire Council Hotline on 01432 261800.**
