Lengthsman Job Description

Qualifications

Applicants should hold current relevant certificates of competence to use a range of equipment including strimmers and chain saws. Successful applicants will be expected to provide all their own equipment including relevant safety wear, basic signage and transport and will have full public liability insurance cover to a minimum of £5 million.

Responsibilities

Within Parish Boundaries successful applicants will be expected to carry out the following minor operations;

1. To keep gully grid tops, drainage grips and highway culverts free of leaves and other debris.
2. To maintain road signs ensuring their general visibility.
3. Trim overgrown hedgerows and trees along footways and trim overgrowth.
4. To sweep and keep tidy all public footways within village boundaries.
5. To clear minor storm debris discharged onto the highway as is reasonable and practical.
6. Carry out any other such work as directed by the Parish Council Lengthsman Co-ordinator or clerk.
7. To inform the Lengthsman Co-ordinator or clerk of any major problems requiring urgent attention.
8. All work undertaken must be done by a works order raised by the council co-ordinator.
