## NDP UPDATE

The Neighbourhood Development Plan Steering group will be collecting responses to the formal Regulation 14 stage of the draft plan until Friday 7th December 2018. Please email your response to [lyonshallparishclerk@gmail.com](mailto:lyonshallparishclerk@gmail.com) or drop a written responses into one of the boxes around the village. Alternatively you can post your responses to the Clerk at Firbanks, Lyonshall HR5 3LN.

All comments received will be compiled into a schedule for the Consultants to review. Each comment will be considered and the plan may be revised where necessary. It is hoped that any alterations can be completed by the end of January and the draft will be ready for the next stages of the process.

The Parish Council will review the next draft for approval along with the basic conditions statement and NDP consultations statement, both prepared by the Consultants. These documents form the basis for the Regulation 15/16 stages of the plan and will be forwarded to Herefordshire Council to conduct their consultation.
