# NDP UPDATE

Lyonshall Draft Neighbourhood Development Plan has now been modified after considering responses received at the Regulation 14 stage.

The amended plan, basic conditions statement and consultation statements have been finalised and completed with the support of consultants and approved at Parish Council. The NDP will now progress to the Regulation 15 stage of the legal process.

# SPEEDING IN THE VILLAGE

The Parish Council has been working hard to help reduce speeding in the village by using signs and police visits but unfortunately there is still a problem. The Parish Council is now investigating other options including the installation of Speed Indicator Devices (SID) or flashing speed signs. Watch this space!

## PARISH FOOTPATHS

Lyonshall has over 25Km of footpaths running throughout the parish. These paths are kept clear and maintained by local landowners. Over the last 5 years, the Parish Council has helped, through grant funding, to improve these routes by installing metal gates and clearing main road entrances. Due to Herefordshire Council cuts there will be no grant funding available from 2019 so all future maintenance will be provided from the Parish Council precept.

To help keep costs down, Parish Council will be holding footpath maintenance days during the spring and summer and are looking for volunteers to join in. If you would like to help please contact the clerk.
