PARISH MOWING CONTRACT

Lyonshall Parish Council invites **tenders for mowing amenity areas in the parish**

to undertake specific mowing duties within the parish from 1st March – 31st October 2020.

Applicants should be self-employed, able to provide their own transport and qualified to use any relevant tools and equipment. In addition they should carry public liability insurance with minimum limit of indemnity of £5 million.
