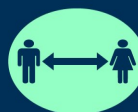

SPEEDING IN THE VILLAGE

*****GREAT NEWS*****



Grant funding has been successfully secured from the Police and Crime Commissioner Office to fully fund the purchase of a new Speed Indicator Device (SID) for the Parish Council.

Along with the installation of a third base along the C1031 (The Royal George to Windy Corner); the initiative is aimed at combating speeding throughout the village.

With the support of the local policing team and erection of the SID over the three base locations at Fishpools, Burgoynes, and the C1031 it is hoped speeding will be reduced.

WINTER INFORMATION

Salt is available for parishioners to use on pavements outside their homes. It is stored in yellow grit bins and bags provided throughout the parish.
