
PUB UPDATE

There has been parishioner frustration with the progress of the Royal George Pub renovation project. The Parish Council along with Cllr Roger Phillips have been working hard to encourage the planning department to support the local housing developments, so that much needed cash from their sales can be funnelled into progressing the ongoing works.

The most complex part of the building, the hole in the ground, has almost been completed. Unfortunately, there was a leak from under the pub itself that filled the hole with water. The leak has been located and it is hoped the concrete spine wall installation will be completed next month to then progress on to the blockwork. The new electric connection has been agreed and paid for and will be installed once the blockwork is finished. The oak and steel frames are expected to be up by spring of next year. Once they are up the old pub building will be scaffolded and renovated. Hopefully when the hole is completed things will be seen to move faster.

Cllr Avery provided a full update on the progress of the Royal George at the recent Annual Parish Meeting on Thursday 6th May. You can read the report on Lyonshall website if you are interested. The buildings and land are the responsibility of the owner not the Parish Council, however he is fully committed to completing the project and reopening the pub.
